



Report on The Third BalticGrid-II AHM

December, 9th-10th, Poznań, Poland



The Third All-Hands Meeting took place in Poznan, Poland, December 9-10, 2009. The meeting was organized by *Poznan Supercomputing and Networking Center* affiliated to *Institute of Bioorganic Chemistry PAS* and held in the premises of the Institute. The event was attended by 50+ people coming from all of the 7 countries and 13 institutions involved in project works. The main goal was the evaluation of the project current status and discussing the tasks for a next stage of the project.
